Historical Background

- **Documented Service:** Records from the United Daughters of the Confederacy list him as serving in Company A, 31st Tennessee Infantry, CSA. This unit was organized in Weakley County, Tennessee.
- **The "Medic" Claim:** Local Tennessee records state that he served as a medic for the Confederate army at the Battle of Shiloh. This role further suggests he was not commanding a line company as a commissioned captain.
- **Association with Forrest:** He was well known in West Tennessee for assisting and feeding the troops of Confederate General Nathan Bedford Forrest. Local lore credits him with helping Forrest escape a Union pursuit near McKenzie just before the Battle of Parker's Crossroads.
- **Post-War Title:** Like many prominent Southern veterans after the Civil War, Baldrige was affectionately given the honorific title of "Captain" by his community and family, which stuck with him for the rest of his life and was inscribed on his grave records.

The 31st Regiment Tennessee Infantry was organized October 12, 1861, and re-organized May 8, 1862. It appears to have been temporarily consolidated with the 33d Regiment Tennessee Infantry in the early part of 1863, which consolidation was discontinued by S. O. No. 130, Hdqrs. Army of Tennessee, dated May 6, 1863. Subsequently the regiment was consolidated into four companies and the battalion thus formed was united with a similar battalion of the 33d Regiment Tennessee Infantry March 9, 1864. In the latter part of 1864 the 4th, 5th, 31st, 33d and 38th Regiments Tennessee Infantry were consolidated but each company of the various organizations was mustered separately and under its original designation during the periods covered by these consolidations.

About April 9, 1865, the 4th, 5th, 19th, 24th, 31st, 33d, 35th, 38th and 41st Regiments Tennessee Infantry were consolidated and formed the 3d Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry which was paroled at Greensboro, N. C., May 1, 1865.
